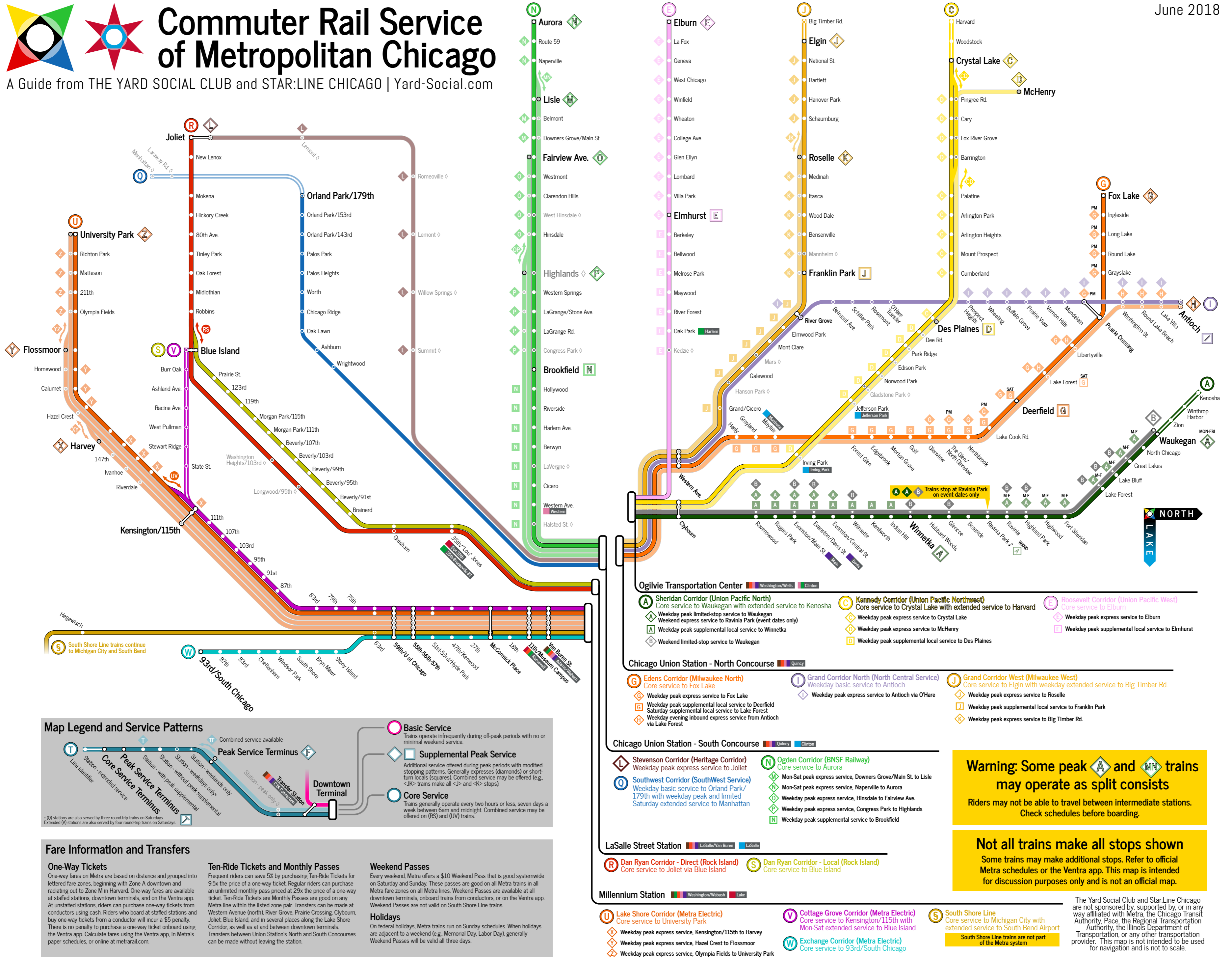


# Commuter Rail Service of Metropolitan Chicago

### Map Legend and Service Patterns

**Basic Service**  
Trains operate infrequently during off-peak periods with no or minimal weekend service.

**Supplemental Peak Service**  
Additional service offered during peak periods with modified stopping patterns. Generally expresses (diamonds) or short-run locals (squares). Combined service may be offered (e.g. <K> trains make all <D> and <K> stops).

**Core Service**  
Trains generally operate every two hours or less, seven days a week between 6am and midnight. Combined service may be offered on (RS) and (UV) trains.

### Fare Information and Transfers

**One-Way Tickets**  
One-way fares on Metra are based on distance and grouped into lettered fare zones, beginning with Zone A downtown and radiating out to Zone M in Hanard. One-way fares are available at staffed stations, downtown terminals, and on the Ventra app. At unstaffed stations, riders can purchase one-way tickets from conductors using cash. Riders who board at staffed stations and buy one-way tickets from a conductor will incur a \$5 penalty. There is no penalty to purchase a one-way ticket onboard using the Ventra app. Calculate fares using the Ventra app, in Metra's paper schedules, or online at metraill.com.

**Ten-Ride Tickets and Monthly Passes**  
Frequent riders can save 5% by purchasing Ten-Ride Tickets for 95¢ the price of a one-way ticket. Regular riders can purchase an unlimited monthly pass priced at 29¢ the price of a one-way ticket. Ten-Ride Tickets are Monthly Passes are good on any Metra line within the listed zone pair. Transfers can be made at Western Avenue (north), River Grove, Prairie Crossing, Clybourn, Joliet, Blue Island, and in several places along the Lake Shore Corridor, as well as at and between downtown terminals. Transfers between Union Station's North and South Concourses can be made without leaving the station.

**Weekend Passes**  
Every weekend, Metra offers a \$10 Weekend Pass that is good systemwide on Saturday and Sunday. These passes are good on all Metra trains in all Metra fare zones on all Metra lines. Weekend Passes are available at all downtown terminals, onboard trains from conductors, or on the Ventra app. Weekend Passes are not valid on South Shore Line trains.

**Holidays**  
On federal holidays, Metra trains run on Sunday schedules. When holidays are adjacent to a weekend (e.g., Memorial Day, Labor Day), generally Weekend Passes will be valid all three days.

Core service to Waukegan with extended service to Kenosha  
Weekday peak limited-stop service to Waukegan  
Weekend express service to Ravinia Park (event dates only)  
Weekday peak supplemental local service to Winnetka  
Weekend limited-stop service to Waukegan
- Kennedy Corridor (Union Pacific Northwest)**  
Core service to Crystal Lake with extended service to Harvard  
Weekday peak express service to Crystal Lake  
Weekday peak express service to McHenry  
Weekday peak supplemental local service to Des Plaines
- Roosevelt Corridor (Union Pacific West)**  
Core service to Elburn
