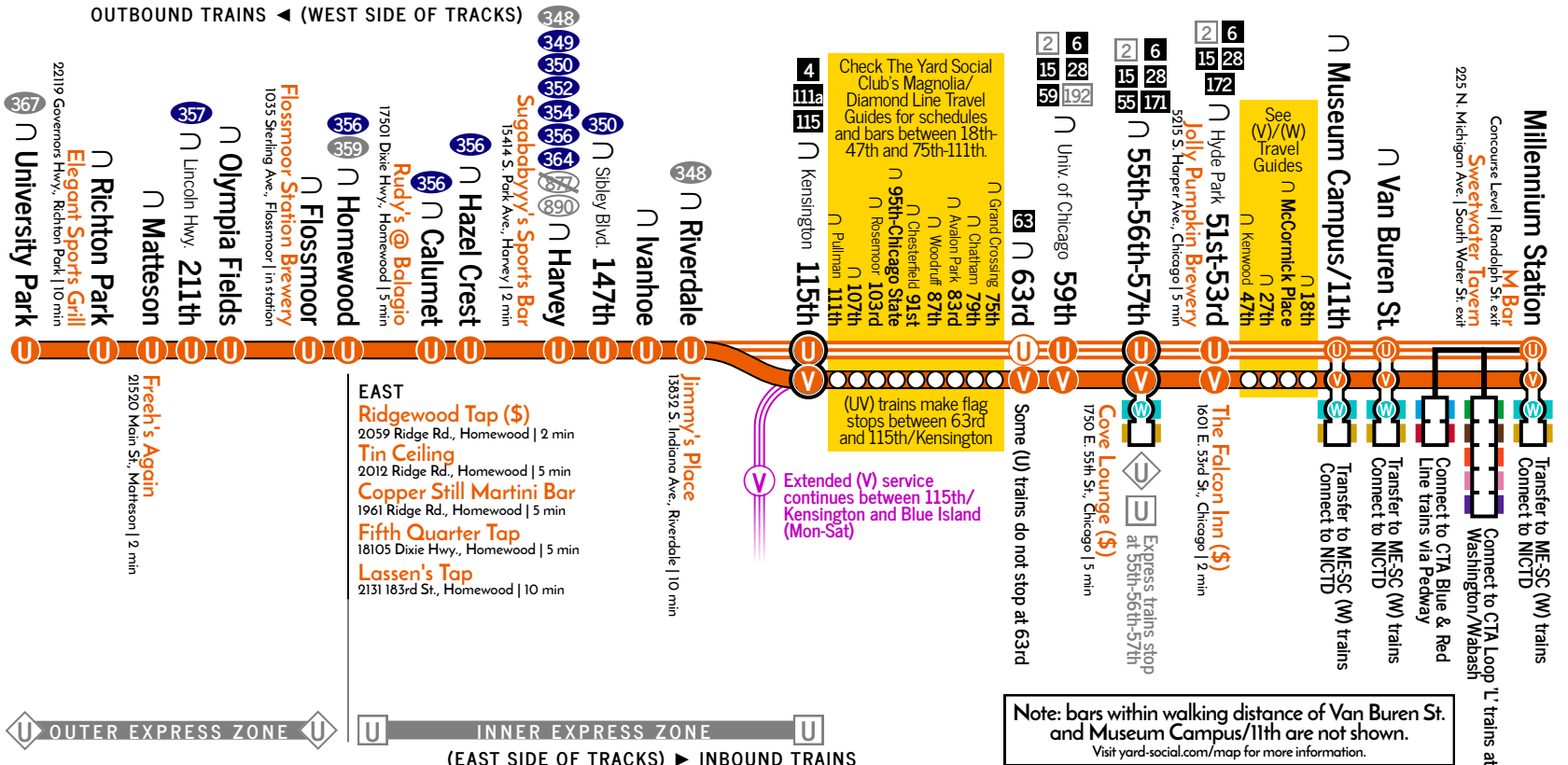

In this fictional sample schedule, six trains a day operate on the SouthEast Service between LaSalle Street Station and Crete, with additional service to Balmoral Park. Inbound trains are read moving bottom-to-top; outbound trains are read moving top-to-bottom. Outbound trains are also shaded. Trains pass where indicated with a gray box and continue in the next column. Times shown in parentheses are flag stops and will only stop upon request.

Fare Information

Through 2023, the Rock Island and Metra Electric lines are participating in Cook County's South Cook Fair Transit Pilot program, which provides reduced-fare ticket options to all Metra riders.

Reduced-fare tickets purchased as part of the South Cook Fair Transit Pilot can only be used on RI and ME trains; all other lines require full fare tickets. Day Passes, Weekend Passes, which are good on all Metra lines, are not available for discounted use; however, full-fare Day/Weekend Passes purchased on other lines are accepted on RI and ME trains during the pilot period.

All ticket options can be purchased via debit/credit card or stored transit value using the Ventra smartphone app. Additionally, one-way, 10-ride, Day Passes, Monthly Passes, and one-day \$7 Weekend Day Passes are available from ticket agents at downtown terminals and select suburban stations. At stations where a ticket agent is not available, one-way and Day Passes (including one-day \$7 Weekend Day Passes) can be purchased from conductors without penalty; conductors accept cash only.
